Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Happy Summer! I hope this August newsletter finds you enjoying warm weather, sunshine, and beautiful flowers and plants during this special season of the calendar year. We are beginning our final month of the church's summer schedule with our combined Sunday worship service and Wednesday Praise at the Park. Thank you to everyone who has joined in worship and fellowship together as we trust that Jesus joins us too as we gather!

While Summer is a time to break from our regular program year, the church has been bustling with a variety of ministries, and you are invited to join in the fun! What do canned ravioli, pans of yummy bars, new bath towels, and barnyard animals have in common? They are all needed for special ongoing and upcoming ways to live out our faith together at Grace.

With children home from school, our food pantry has been especially busy with guests. We welcome you to consider bringing in easy to eat foods like canned ravioli, peanut butter, microwave mac 'n' cheese, canned chili, granola bars, cereal, applesauce cups, and canned fruit and vegetables for the Grace pantry. Household items like toilet paper, cleaning supplies, feminine hygiene products, and personal care items are also needed.

And for those who enjoy baking, you will find a table in the Gathering Space which has foil 9x13 pans. For our special service on August 10, Worship by the Water, we invite you to provide treats for fellowship at Ward Park. Please take a pan and return it filled with any kind of pre-cut bars, brownies, or treats, and we will share them with our neighbors who come to worship. For those worshipping on their boats that day, be on the lookout for bulletins and blessed communion elements in the Gathering Space to pick up in advance. We will bring bulletins and elements to the park for those worshipping on the shore.

Another opportunity to join in the fun is an easy service opportunity. For those who prefer to shop instead of bake, the Missions Team is collecting new towels, bars of soap, nail clippers, toothbrushes, and combs for Lutheran World Relief personal care kits. We will assemble these kits together along with other fun projects on Sunday, September 7, for God's Work. Our Hands Sunday. This day of service and fellowship begins with worship where we will bless our kids and teachers for the school year ahead so be sure to bring your backpacks!

Our service projects will also include learning about God's Global Barnyard which is an ELCA World Hunger ministry (<https://goodgifts.elca.org/all-gifts>). You will be invited to purchase chicks (\$10), a rooster (\$15), honeybees (\$20), a piglet (\$30), a goat (\$50), and even join with others to purchase a share of a fish farm or cows! These live-giving animals help feed families around the world. You will even get to meet some animals as we welcome a petting zoo to Grace for the morning. Please invite your friends and neighbors to come as we kick off our program year together!

Thank you to everyone who has made this summer special with your attendance at worship, fellowship activities, and continuing to serve on various ministry teams. The sharing of your time, presence, financial support, gifts, and skills helps our congregation share the good news of Jesus inside and out of our walls. The Holy Spirit has called us to be part of Grace at this moment in time to bring hope through the power of Christ's healing love. Thank you for putting your faith into action in so many ways. And remember, wherever you go, Jesus is with you!





Monthly Men's Breakfast:


Men of all ages are invited to a monthly breakfast at The Ranch restaurant on the first Monday of the month. Come for a devotion, fellowship, and good breakfast food.





Sunday, August 3 - Pentecost 8

Today's texts offer instruction and encouragement for all who are occasionally overwhelmed by the "unhappy business" of life. Jesus urges us to take care and be on guard against all kinds of greed. We who have died with Christ in holy baptism have also been raised with him and are encouraged to elevate our thinking, seeking the "things that are above." To that end we seek the sustenance of the Lord's supper and the encouragement of God's word.
