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Tune My Heart To Sing Thy Grace



Many hymns that we sing together are loaded with wonderful nuggets of faith. One classic hymn is “Come Thou Fount of Every Blessing.” Some of the words that I love are, “Tune my Heart to Sing Thy Grace.” Perhaps this profound proclamation of faith is also on my mind because we just celebrated another one of our big service days called, “God’s Grace is Amazing.” The truth is our hearts do at times need tuning, repair work, or being rewired to sing of the grace of God once again. This phrase also reinvigorates, brings to life, and continues to carry forward. Matthew 5 shares some of the many opportunities of kingdom work and kingdom building. Jesus practically turns everything upside down and focuses on the least, the marginalized, and people groups that don’t seem to get the same respect as others. In this passage Jesus uses the word blessed, but this time lets insert these words of, “Tune my Heart to Sing Thy Grace.” Jesus says, tune my heart to the poor in spirit, tune my heart to those who mourn, tune my heart to the meek, tune my heart to those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, tune my heart to the pure in heart, and tune my heart to the peacemakers. Jesus speaks these words directly into a world that is broken and in need of healing, comfort, and rebuilding. Jesus makes known here just a little about who to bless and who to tune our hearts too. **So, tune my heart to sing thy grace throughout these summer months, especially as you remain being attentive to all your neighbors.** Thanks be to God. Amen.

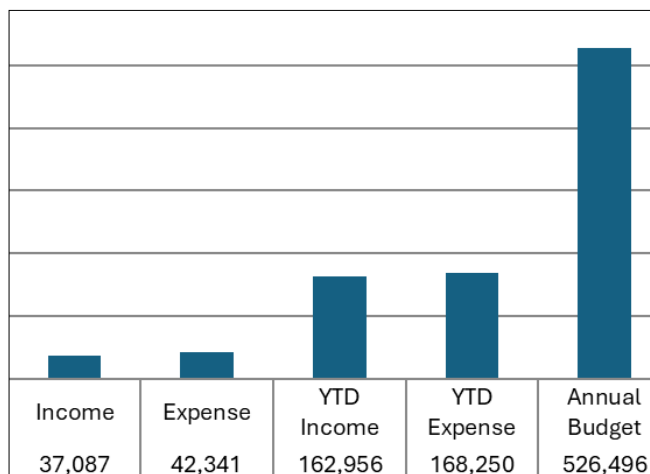

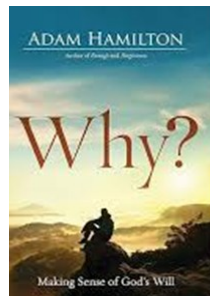

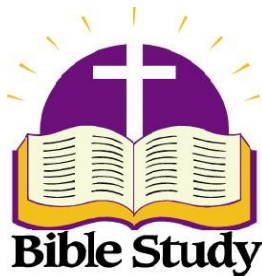

WORDS FOR WORSHIP

Sunday, June 7

Though Jesus was a devout Jew who practiced his faith, he was criticized for eating with tax collectors and sinners—the religiously nonobservant. Jesus criticizes the self-righteous and reminds us that mercy is to be at the heart of our religious practices. God continues to be made known in those on the margins of society, like Matthew the tax collector and the hemorrhaging woman. As we gather each Lord's day we receive the healing that makes us well and sends us forth to be signs of God's mercy for the world.

First Reading: Hosea 5:15—6:6

Second Reading: Romans 4:13-25

Gospel: Matthew 9:9-13, 18-26

Sunday, June 14

Moses tells the Israelites that they are called to be a priestly kingdom and a holy people. Jesus sends out the disciples as laborers into the harvest. In baptism we too are anointed for ministry, sharing God's compassion with our needy world. From the Lord's table we go forth to proclaim the good news, to heal the sick, and to share our bread with the hungry.

First Reading: Exodus 19:2-8a

Second Reading: Romans 5:1-8

Gospel: Matthew 9:35—10:8 [9-23]

Sunday, June 21

God does not promise that the path of the disciple will be easy. Jeremiah feels the pain of rejection from those who do not want to hear what he has to say. Jesus declares that his words may bring stark division. Even so, we

need not be afraid for God accounts for each hair on our heads. Though we may experience rejection, frustration, division, and death, God's grace and love make us a new creation each day. Marked with the cross and filled with holy food, we are sent from worship to witness to Christ in the world.

First Reading: Jeremiah 20:7-13

Second Reading: Romans 6:1b-11

Gospel: Matthew 10:24-39

Sunday, June 28

The welcome of baptism is for all God's children. This baptismal gift sets us free from the power of sin and death. In today's gospel, Christ promises that the disciple who gives a cup of cold water to the little ones serves Christ himself. From worship we are sent on our baptismal mission: to serve the little ones of this world and to be a sign of God's merciful welcome.
