## Planning the Service

Please contact Grace Lutheran Church as your loved one is nearing death. Our office number is (507) 238-4418. If you would like a pastoral visit, our pastors will gladly visit at your home or hospital. Chaplains at our hospital and care facility are also available for visits but due to privacy laws, they are unable to share their visit with your pastors. Pastors are only informed if a parishioner is in the hospital if informed by the family or friends.

Funerals are held at the church most days with the exceptions of holidays and Sundays. Visitation can be held at the church or funeral home. The pastors at Grace Lutheran will conduct the funeral unless otherwise agreed to in advance. Grace Lutheran will prepare your funeral bulletin. The pastor will consult with you on your selections of scripture, hymns, and special music to accompany the Lutheran funeral service.
